**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

**Discuss Community Outreach Events; and Action Thereon**

**Love-Wisconsin Event**

Rev. John Norquist described doing an event that would bring people together to share their stories about race. We could make something similar to the Fireside Chat series and use the same format. He will work on developing that more. Discussion ensued. Everyone thought it is a great idea. Council Member Bublitz asked if we could hold it in the library by the fireplace making it a comfortable space to share stories. Rev. Norquist will follow up with Erica Turner to see if there are people that went through the training she does that could be the first ones to share these stories. Hayden Knight talked about bringing in a Jazz musician to learn about the history of Jazz. Amit Kaul mentioned that the CPAC might become available in the future for film nights. Theme for the chats would be focused on race. Administrator Hilvo stated that the chat series could be done monthly from September through May at the Library. There will be more discussion at the next meeting.

**Workshop/Webinar**

Dr. Joyce Caldwell and Administrator Hilvo will continue to work on DEI educational classes for Council Members and City Staff.

**Discuss Affordable/Workforce Housing; and Action Thereon**

Rev. Norquist introduced DJ Burns to talk about his experience with affordable housing. DJ Burns discussed what he has done in the past and the possibilities for Cedarburg. He challenged the Committee to look at what we are doing as a community to deter or promote workforce housing. Changing the Zoning Code would be a start to providing opportunities. There are challenges to developing workforce housing, but they can be overcome. DJ Burns offered to continue helping the Committee as we continue to discuss workforce housing. Council Member Bublitz wants to continue having this conversation with focus on how developers can make these developments with the current high cost of land. DJ Burns discussed a potential land trust that could help provide low cost land to developers. As a committee, we can work on developing a plan for the community that focuses on future workforce housing.

Amit Kaul shared what the group has been working on. Peace in the Park and Film Night are scheduled for August this year.
