Planner Censky located a photo of the building taken in the 1950s that shows there was a window in the location of the present door. Cedar Corporation will remove the existing stairway, necessary for an emergency exit when the building was used as a restaurant. A new Pella Architect Series window will be installed in the opening from the existing fire door. The window is wood on both sides with thermopane glass. The siding below the window will be infilled, and the detailing will match the existing exterior. The aluminum fan equipment from the restaurant kitchen has already been removed.
