Consider proposed temporary signage for Bank First (former Partnership Bank) located at W61 N529 Washington Avenue; and action thereon.

Rod Caspersen of Signarama, representing Bank First, explained that the façade of the bank is being remodeled. This signage change will be considered as permanent; however, changes to the signage may need to be made with the presentation of the new façade. If so, a change will come before Landmarks Commission at a future date. The sign under consideration is smaller than the current one, with 1” thick black matte lettering, and is made of the same material as the current sign. The same signage will be posted on the east- and north-facing facades of the bank.
