ORDINANCE NO. 2017-17

An Ordinance Repealing Sections 10-1-34(a)(4) and (a)(5) of the Municipal Code Which Established Loading Zones in front the former Library and the South Side of Zeunert Street

The Common Council of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 10-1-34(a)(4) and (a)(5) of the Municipal Code of the City of Cedarburg are hereby repealed as follows:

SEC. 10-1-34 LOADING ZONE PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

- (a) **General Loading Zones.** No person shall park, stop, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, except while loading or unloading passengers, material or merchandise from such vehicle on the following streets or parts thereof:
 - (4) On the west side of Hanover Avenue, commencing at a point one hundred forty-five (145) feet north of the north property line of Center Street at the intersection of Hanover Avenue extending north thirty (30) feet.
 - (5) On the south side of Zeunert Street, commencing one hundred thirty (130) feet from the intersecting curb line of Cardinal Avenue and Zeunert Street for a distance of two hundred forty-two (242) feet to the west.
