Healthy trees mean healthy people:

- 100 trees remove 53 tons of carbon dioxide and 430 lbs. of other air pollutants per year.

- Strategically placed trees save up to 56% on annual airconditioning bills and 3% on winter heating bills.
- Each large front yard tree adds 1% to a home's sale price and a large specimen tree can add 10% to property value.

Healthy trees mean better business:

- In tree-lined commercial shopping districts, shoppers report:
 - more frequent shopping trips.
 - longer shopping trips.
 - willingness to pay more for parking.
 - willingness to spend 12% more for goods.

Trees pay us back:

- One healthy public tree in its 20th year after planting costs \$36 per year to maintain but provides \$96 in annual economic benefits; an annual net benefit of \$60!
- Environmental and aesthetic benefits, such as energy savings, storm water runoff reduction, cleaner air, and higher property values, are an average of 3 times greater than tree care costs!

Facts About Cedarburg's Forest

- The Cedarburg Parks & Forestry Department maintains approximately 7,000 street trees.
- Each year, an average of 130 street trees are removed due to decline, decay, or structural defect.
- The cost to replace a single street tree that has been removed is about \$250.
- Past city budgets have only allowed replacement of about 50 trees per year, far less than the number removed. The net result is a decrease in our street tree population over time.
- One goal of the Parks & Forestry Department is to establish a routine Pruning Cycle where each public tree is pruned on a 5-7 year cycle.
- The Parks & Forestry Department has a full time staff of only three employees and must rely on the Public Works staff to help with pruning and tree and stump removal. Some years, depending on the weather and staff availability, routine maintenance of the street and park trees doesn't happen like it should.
- In 2012 the Parks & Forestry Dept. completed an inventory of street trees throughout the City which identified tree species, location, size, condition and where vacant planting sites exist. The inventory identified 320 vacant tree planting sites.
- Another goal of the Parks & Forestry Department is 100% stocking of street trees; meaning every vacant, plantable site along City streets is planted. The cost to plant the 320 sites and achieve 100% stocking is around \$80,000.
- In 2011, the City of Cedarburg joined 10 other communities in the U.S. named by *Forbes* magazine as "One of the Prettiest Towns in America". Unfortunately, due to budget constraints in recent years, several City beautification projects have been on hold.
