A Resolution Honoring Patrol Sergeant John Stroik

WHEREAS, John Stroik has completed thirty-five years of service with the Cedarburg Police Department; beginning his employment as a Patrol Officer on October 29, 1981; and

WHEREAS, during his thirty-five years of service, John Stroik has conscientiously and capably served the Cedarburg Police Department, the City of Cedarburg, and its citizenry; and has demonstrated the highest principles of community service while exhibiting high moral and ethical standards; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Stroik demonstrated sound judgment and decision-making in matters involving the Cedarburg Police Department; and his integrity, courtesy, and professionalism earned him the respect of the community, his co-workers, and peers; and

WHEREAS, during his service as a member of the Cedarburg Police Department, Sergeant Stroik was promoted to Patrol Sergeant in September 1988, serving in that position for twenty-eight years; was instrumental in the Police Department's technology improvements related to computers, software and networking; served as the police liaison officer to the Cedarburg Auxiliary Police/Emergency Management and worked to greatly improve their training, policies and record keeping; supervised, trained and coordinated school crossing guards for the Police Department and Cedarburg School District; and supervised the Field Training Officer program; and

WHEREAS, the Cedarburg Police Department and the City of Cedarburg have benefited significantly from the dedicated law enforcement skills and services of Sergeant Stroik;


