A Resolution Honoring Tracey Rink

WHEREAS, Tracey Rink has completed twenty nine years of employment as an Operator/Collection System Technician with the City of Cedarburg; beginning his employment at the Wastewater Treatment Plant on January 11, 1988; and

WHEREAS, Tracey Rink began as an Operator 1 and advanced to an Operator II position, then became Collection System Technician for twenty two years while becoming certified in all subcategories assigned to the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant and has attained the level of Grade 4, the highest level that the DNR gives for treatment plant operators; and

WHEREAS, Tracey Rink has conscientiously and capably served the City of Cedarburg and its citizens by maintaining the wastewater treatment plant, laboratory, lift stations and sanitary sewers to assure the effluent discharge into Cedar Creek consistently meets limits established by the WPDES Permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS, Tracey Rink in addition to his regular duties, worked on the initial purchasing and operation of the City's first jet/vac truck. And he was part of the implementation of the City's GIS mapping program, and worked as a fill-in inspector for street projects; and


WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Cedarburg have greatly benefited from the dedicated skills of Tracey Rink; and his integrity, courtesy, and professionalism have earned him the respect of the community, his co-workers, and peers.
